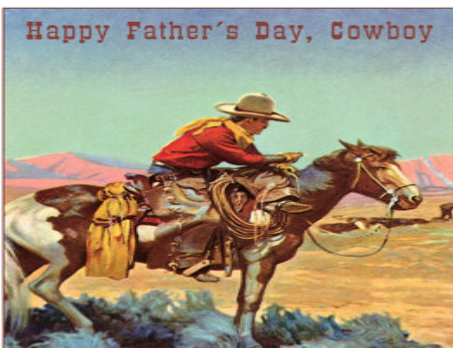

Traits of an Encourager:

1. A “son of encouragement” is a _____

Acts 4:36-37 (NIV) Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means Son of Encouragement), sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet.

2. A “son of encouragement” is _____

Acts 9:27 (NIV) But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. He told them how Saul on his journey had seen the Lord and that the Lord had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had preached fearlessly in the name of Jesus.

3. A “son of encouragement” is a _____

Acts 13:7 (NIV) who was an attendant of the proconsul, Sergius Paulus. The proconsul, an intelligent man, sent for Barnabas and Saul because he wanted to hear the word of God

Results of an Encourager:

1. Leaders are _____:

Acts 13:43 (NIV) many of the Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who talked with them and urged them to continue in the grace of God.

Acts 14:1 (NIV) At Iconium Paul and Barnabas went as usual into the Jewish synagogue. There they spoke so effectively that a great number of Jews and Gentiles believed.

2. Encouragement is _____:

Col. 4:10 (NIV) My fellow prisoner Aristarchus sends you his greetings, as does Mark, the cousin of Barnabas. (You have received instructions about him; if he comes to you, welcome him.)

Galatians 2:1 (NIV) Fourteen years later I went up again to Jerusalem, this time with Barnabas. I took Titus along also.

3. Generations are _____:

1 Cor. 4:17 (NIV) ... I am sending to you Timothy, my son whom I love, who is faithful in the Lord. He will remind you of my way of life in Christ Jesus, which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church.

Philemon 1:10 (NIV) I appeal to you for my son Onesimus, who became my son while I was in chains.
