

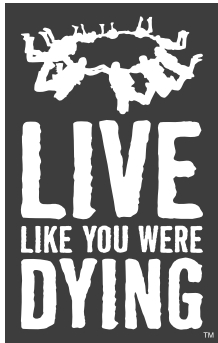

# One of the “Others”

**Hebrews 11:6 (NIV)** And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

## 1. Faith is born from a \_\_\_\_\_ to God

“The Lord said to Moses ”

**Matthew 4:19,20 (NIV)** "Come, follow me," Jesus said ... At once they left their nets and followed him

## 2. Faith leads to \_\_\_\_\_

**Hebrews 11:7 (GW)** Faith led Noah to listen when God warned him about the things in the future that he could not see. He obeyed God and built a ship to save his family.

**Hebrews 11:32-34 (NLT)** Well, how much more do I need to say? It would take too long to recount the stories of the faith of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and all the prophets. [33] By faith these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice, and received what God had promised them. They shut the mouths of lions, [34] quenched the flames of fire, and escaped death by the edge of the sword. Their weakness was turned to strength. They became strong in battle and put whole armies to flight.

## 3. Faith moves the ordinary to the \_\_\_\_\_

**Hebrews 11:11 (GW)** Faith enabled Abraham to become a father, even though he was old and Sarah had never been able to have children. Abraham trusted that God would keep his promise.

**Hebrews 11:36-37 (NIV)** Some faced jeers and flogging, while still others were chained and put in prison. [37] They were stoned; they were sawed in two; they were put to death by the sword. They went about in sheepskins and goatskins, destitute, persecuted and mistreated--

## 4. True Faith is \_\_\_\_\_ by God

**Hebrews 11:39 (NIV)** These were all commended for their faith,

**Hebrews 11:39-40 (TEV)** What a record all of these have won by their faith! Yet they did not receive what God had promised, [40] because God had decided on an even better plan for us. His purpose was that only in company with us would they be made perfect.
