# “Speak Sweeter”

**Proverbs 18:21 (NIV)** The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

**James 3:9-10 (NIV)** With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God's likeness. [10] Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be.

## 1 Appreciate people...

**Col. 2:7 (NLT)** ... Let your lives overflow with thanksgiving for all he has done.

### **Life is hard but...**

**1 Thes. 5:18 (NIV)** give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

**Luke 17:12-18 (NIV)** As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. [16] He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him--and he was a Samaritan. Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? [18] Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?"

**1 Thes. 5:11 (NIV)** Therefore encourage one another and build each other up,...

**Luke 24:51 (NIV)** While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up into heaven.

**Proverbs 16:24 (TEV)** Kind words are like honey—sweet to the taste and good for your health.

**Hebrews 3:13 (NIV)** But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.
