Giving Forgiveness

Psalm 118:24 (NIV) This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalm 90:12 (TEV) Teach us how short our life is, so that we may become wise.

Romans 12:18 (NCV) Do your best to live in peace with everyone.

1. You've been freed from God's judgment - CELEBRATE that today

Romans 3:10 (NLT) "No one is good—not even one.

Ephes. 2:3 (NLT) We were born with an evil nature, and we were under God's anger...

Col. 1:21-22 (TEV) At one time you were far away from God and were his enemies because of the evil things you did and thought. But now, by means of the physical death of his Son, God has made you his friends, in order to bring you, holy, pure, and faultless, into his presence.

2. Release others from your judgment - starting today

Proverbs 19:11 (CEV) It's wise to be patient and show what you are like by forgiving others.

Col. 3:13 (NLT) You must make allowance for each other's faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.

Luke 6:27-28 (NIV) "... Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

Luke 6:35-36 (NIV) But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great... Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

Job 42:10 (NIV) After Job had prayed for his friends, the Lord made him prosperous again...

3. Free yourself & others - Life is Short

Matthew 18:32-35 (CEV) The king called the first official back in and said, "You're an evil man! When you begged for mercy, I said you did not have to pay back a cent. [33] Don't you think you should show pity to someone else, as I did to you?" [34] The king was so angry that he ordered the official to be tortured until he could pay back everything he owed. [35] That is how my Father in heaven will treat you, if you don't forgive each of my followers with all your heart.

Hebrews 12:15 (NIV) See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many.
