Embrace Eternity

Luke 12:13-21 (NLT) Then someone called from the crowd, "Teacher, please tell my brother to divide our father's estate with me." [14] Jesus replied, "Friend, who made me a judge over you to decide such things as that?" [15] Then he said, "Beware! Don't be greedy for what you don't have. Real life is not measured by how much we own." [16] And he gave an illustration: "A rich man had a fertile farm that produced fine crops. [17] In fact, his barns were full to overflowing. [18] So he said, 'I know! I'll tear down my barns and build bigger ones. Then I'll have room enough to store everything. [19] And I'll sit back and say to myself, My friend, you have enough stored away for years to come. Now take it easy! Eat, drink, and be merry!' [20] "But God said to him, 'You fool! You will die this very night. Then who will get it all?' [21] "Yes, a person is a fool to store up earthly wealth but not have a rich relationship with God."

3 Common Mistakes

1. You make a Fatal Miscalculation - you live like this life is all there is

1 Cor. 15:19 (NLT) And if we have hope in Christ only for this life, we are the most miserable people in the world.

Eccles. 3:11 (NLT) God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart, but even so, people cannot see the whole scope of God's work from beginning to end.

Eccles. 2:18 (TEV) Nothing that I had worked for and earned meant a thing to me, because I knew that I would have to leave it to my successor,

Matthew 6:19-21 (NLT) "Don't store up treasures here on earth, where they can be eaten by moths and get rusty, and where thieves break in and steal. [20] Store your treasures in heaven, where they will never become moth-eaten or rusty and where they will be safe from thieves. [21] Wherever your treasure is, there your heart and thoughts will also be.

2. You Procrastinate- there's always tomorrow

James 4:14 (NLT) How do you know what will happen tomorrow? For your life is like the morning fog—it's here a little while, then it's gone.

3. You're Unprepared- you don't live his life like there was life to come

2 Cor. 4:17-18 & 5.1(NIV) For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. [18] So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. Now we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands.

1 Cor. 2:9 (NIV) "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him"--

Luke 9:25 (NLT) And how do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul in the process?

Hebrews 9:27 (NIV) Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment,
