Who Are You Countin' On

God's indictment of our times:

1. 21st century idol worship- money
2. Trusting in material things instead of God
3. We have led our children down the same path

Jeremiah 17:1-4 (NIV) "Judah's sin is engraved with an iron tool, inscribed with a flint point, on the tablets of their hearts and on the horns of their altars. [2] Even their children remember their altars and Asherah pole beside the spreading trees and on the high hills. [3] My mountain in the land and your wealth and all your treasure I will give away as plunder, together with your high places, because of sin throughout your country. [4] Through your own fault you will lose the inheritance I gave you. I will enslave you to your enemies in a land you do not know, for you have kindled my anger, and it will burn forever."

Our Two Choices:

1. Continue to serve these other gods till we have nothing left.

Jeremiah 17:5-6 (NIV) This is what the Lord says: "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who depends on flesh for his strength and whose heart turns away from the Lord. [6] He will be like a bush in the wastelands; he will not see prosperity when it comes. He will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives.

2. Turn from this way of life to real life God's way.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NIV) "But blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him. [8] He will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

A. Pain may be part of God's process

Habakkuk 3:17-18 (NIV) Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, [18] yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior.

B. There is hope in Christ alone

Philip. 4:6-7 (NIV) Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. [7] And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
