A Balanced Ride: Heart to Head

Romans 12:2a (NIV) 2b (NLT) Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is.

The Pattern - “It’s all about me”

I want this, I can do this I want it my way, Nobody can tell me what to do, I need this to be fulfilled, This is my life I’ll do what I want,

Ro. 12.2a (NIV) Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world
What areas of life does this effect: money, sex, pleasure, work, church, God,

Ephes. 4:17-18 (NLT) Live no longer as the ungodly do, for they are hopelessly confused. [18] Their closed minds are full of darkness; they are far away from the life of God because they have shut their minds and hardened their hearts against him.

Heart to Head

“Let God transform you into a new person by the renewing of your mind”

1. Allow the Holy Spirit to **renew** your thought

2 Cor. 5:17 (NIV) ... if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

Romans 8:5 (NIV) Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

2. Allow the Holy Spirit to **retrain** your thinking

John 14:26 (NIV) But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

1 Peter 1:13 (NIV) Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

3. Allow the Holy Spirit to **redirect** your thinking

Col. 3:2 (NIV) Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Philip. 4:8 (NIV) Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.
