A Balanced Ride: Social Balance

Romans 12:16 "Live in harmony with one another." v. 18 "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everybody."

Two different places where we need balance

1. Ridin' the home range

Romans 12:16 "Live in harmony with one another."

a. Love each other

1 Peter 2:17 (NIV) ... Love the brotherhood of believers, fear God, honor the king.

b. We are to teach each other

1 Tim. 4:12 (MsgB) ... Teach believers with your life: by word, by demeanor, by love, by faith, by integrity.

c. We are to hold each other accountable

Galatians 6:1 (NIV) Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted.

d. Join with each other as a family

Philip. 3:17 (NIV) Join with others in following my example, brothers, and take note of those who live according to the pattern we gave you.

2. Ridin' out the gate

a. We leave the judging to God

1 Cor. 5:12-13 (NIV) What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? ... God will judge those outside.

b. We have to show we care for strays

Matthew 9:10-12 (NIV) While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and "sinners" came and ate with him and his disciples. [11] When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and 'sinners'?" On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick.

c. We ride with a purpose and a plan

Matthew 28:19 (NIV) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, ...

1 Cor. 9:22 (NIV) To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all things to all men so that by all possible means I might save some.
