# Walk The Talk - The Curse Of The Cuckle-burr

## 1. Cuckle-burr revenge gets you nowhere.

“God will bless you for this, if you endure the pain of undeserved suffering because you are conscious of his will. [20] For what credit is there if you endure the beatings you deserve for having done wrong? But if you endure suffering even when you have done right, God will bless you for it.”

**Matthew 5:9 (NIV)** Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.

## 2. God allows cuckle-burrs in our own lives to shape us to be like Christ

[21] It was to this that God called you, for Christ himself suffered for you and left you an example, so that you would follow in his steps. [22] He committed no sin, and no one ever heard a lie come from his lips. [23] When he was insulted, he did not answer back with an insult; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but placed his hopes in God, the righteous Judge.

**Romans 12:19 (TEV)** Never take revenge, my friends, but instead let God's anger do it. For the scripture says, "I will take revenge, I will pay back, says the Lord."

**1 Peter 2:15 (NIV)** For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish men.

## 3. Forgiveness draws us to close to God and burns cuckle-burrs up

[24] Christ himself carried our sins in his body to the cross, so that we might die to sin and live for righteousness. It is by his wounds that you have been healed.

[25] You were like sheep that had lost their way, but now you have been brought back to follow the Shepherd and Keeper of your souls.

**Col. 3:13 (NIV)** Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

**Hebrews 10:22 (NIV)** let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.
