

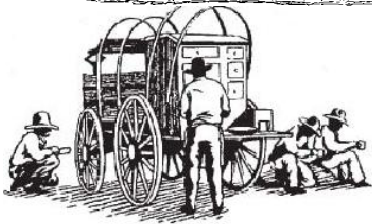

Walk The Talk- Livin' The Good Life

1 Peter 3:8-12 (NIV) Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble. [9] Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing. [10] For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from deceitful speech. [11] He must turn from evil and do good; he must seek peace and pursue it. [12] For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

1. I will put others first

"Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble. [9] Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing."

Romans 12:15 (NIV) Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.

Romans 12:10 (NIV) Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.

2. I will tame my tongue

"Whoever would love life and see good days must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from deceitful speech."

Proverbs 17:28 (NIV) Even a fool is thought wise if he keeps silent, and discerning if he holds his tongue.

James 3:6 (NIV) The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole person, sets the whole course of his life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.

3. I will practice good deeds and live a peaceful life

"He must turn from evil and do good; he must seek peace and pursue it."

Galatians 6:10 (NIV) Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

Isaiah 32:17 (NIV) The fruit of righteousness will be peace; the effect of righteousness will be quietness and confidence forever.

[12] For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."
