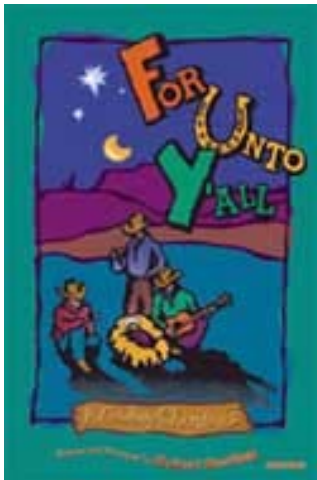

The Gift

2 Cor. 9:15 (NIV) Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

1. This gift comes wrapped by the prophets

Genesis 22:18 (NIV) and through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed..."

Numbers 24:17 (Living) I see in the future of Israel, Far down the distant trail, That there shall come a star from Jacob! This ruler of Israel

Isaiah 7:14 (NIV) ...The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.

Isaiah 53:2 (NIV) He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him.

2. This gift comes boxed with history

Galatians 4:4 (NIV) But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law,

- (a) Common language (Greek)
- (b) Roman roads (to carry the message)
- (c) Political circumstances (census)

3. This gift comes covered in mystery

John 1:1-3 (NIV) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] He was with God in the beginning. [3] Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. [14] The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.

Col. 1:15-22 (NIV) He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. [16] For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. [17] He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. [18] And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. [19] For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, [20] and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. [21] Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. [22] But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation--

Hebrews 1:1-2 (NIV) In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, [2] but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son...
