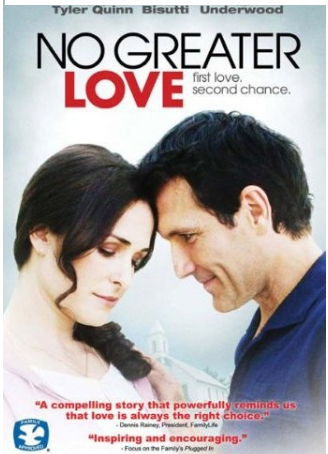

In God We Trust

Trust of anything comes from at least 3 places

- ♦ Can I trust this is good for me ?
- ♦ Can I trust this will be able ?
- ♦ Can I trust this based on my past experiences?

Psalm 32:10b (NIV) the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the man who trusts in him.

1. God is good

Psalm 100:5 (NIV) For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

James 1:17 (NIV) Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

2 Cor. 12:9-10 (NIV) But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. [10] That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

2. God is able

2 Tim. 1:12 (NIV) That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.

Hebrews 7:25 (NIV) Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

3. God and I have a history

Psalm 34:8 (NIV) Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in him.

Job 42:2-3 (NIV) "I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted. [3] You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my counsel without knowledge?' Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know.

Ephes. 3:20-21 (NIV) Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, [21] to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
