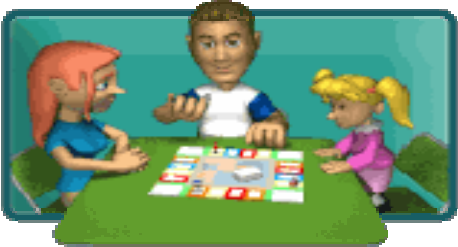
Experience Easter:

The Stones Will Cry Out

Luke 9:51 (NIV) Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem.

1. Crowds- the curious and the miracle seekers

John 12:12-13 (NIV) The next day the great crowd that had come for the Feast heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. [13] They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Blessed is the King of Israel!"

John 12:18 (NIV) Many people, because they had heard that he had given this miraculous sign, went out to meet him.

Matthew 21:10-11 (NIV) When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" [11] The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee."

2. Religious- The status quo and the elite

Isaiah 29:13 (NIV) The Lord says: "These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is made up only of rules taught by men."

Luke 19:39-40 (NIV) Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!" "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."

John 12:19 (NIV) So the Pharisees said to one another, "See, this is getting us nowhere. Look how the whole world has gone after him!"

3. Disciples- true but hesitant followers

John 12:16 (NIV) At first his disciples did not understand all this. Only after Jesus was glorified did they realize that these things had been written about him and that they had done these things to him.

Matthew 7:21-22 (NIV) "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. [22] Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?'

John 20:28 (NIV) Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

Philip. 2:9-11 (NIV) Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, [10] that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, [11] and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
