Herd Mentality vs. God's Freedom

Rev. 1:5 (NIV) ... Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. ... and has freed us from our sins by his blood,

1. God's freedom means I let God fight my battles

Romans 12:19 (MsgB) Don't insist on getting even; that's not for you to do. "I'll do the judging," says God. "I'll take care of it."

1 Peter 2:13-15 (NIV) Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every authority instituted among men: whether to the king, as the supreme authority, or to governors, who are sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to commend those who do right. For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish men.

2. God's freedom means I gain freedom from my possessions

Matthew 6:26 (NIV) Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?

Romans 8:6 (MsgB) Obsession with self in these matters is a dead end; attention to God leads us out into the open, into a spacious, free life.

3. God's freedom means I gain a new perspective

Matthew 6:33 (NIV) But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

4. God's freedom means I gain eternal things

Romans 6:22-23 (NIV) But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. [23] For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Galatians 5:13 (NIV) You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love.
