Wrangling for Jesus

Matthew 9:35-10:14 (MsgB) Then Jesus made a circuit of all the towns and villages. He taught in their meeting places, reported kingdom news, and healed their diseased bodies, healed their bruised and hurt lives. [36] When he looked out over the crowds, his heart broke. So confused and aimless they were, like sheep with no shepherd. [37] "What a huge harvest!" he said to his disciples. "How few workers! [38] On your knees and pray for harvest hands!" Jesus sent his twelve harvest hands out with this charge: "Don't begin by traveling to some far-off place to convert unbelievers. And don't try to be dramatic by tackling some public enemy. [6] Go to the lost, confused people right here in the neighborhood. [7] Tell them that the kingdom is here. [8] Bring health to the sick. Raise the dead. Touch the untouchables. Kick out the demons. You have been treated generously, so live generously. [9] "Don't think you have to put on a fund-raising campaign before you start. [10] You don't need a lot of equipment. You are the equipment, and all you need to keep that going is three meals a day. Travel light. [11] "When you enter a town or village, don't insist on staying in a luxury inn. Get a modest place with some modest people, and be content there until you leave. [12] "When you knock on a door, be courteous in your greeting. [13] If they welcome you, be gentle in your conversation. [14] If they don't welcome you, quietly withdraw. Don't make a scene. Shrug your shoulders and be on your way.

What kind of people is Jesus looking for ?

1. Wranglers with a **Passion** for people: church for the unchurched
2. Wranglers with a **focused mission**: The Cowboy culture
3. Wranglers who know this is **God's doing**:

John 15:5 (MsgB) "I am the Vine, you are the branches. When you're joined with me and I with you, the relation intimate and organic, the harvest is sure to be abundant. Separated, you can't produce a thing.
