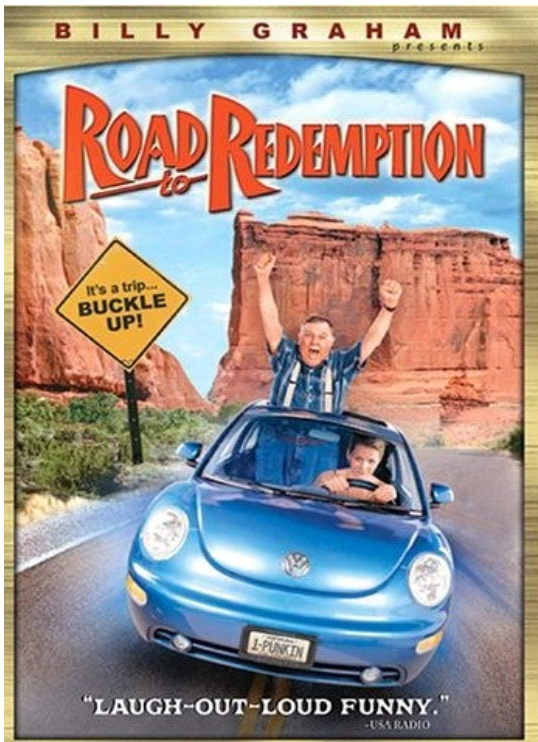

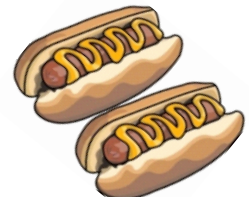

Mad Cow Disease - Unforgiveness

Romans 12:17-19,21 (NIV) [17] Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. [18] If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. [19] Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. ... [21] Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

1. Identify the problem

Romans 12:17 Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. [18] If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Ephesians 6:12 (NIV) For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

James 3:16 (NIV) For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

2. Look for a way out

Romans 12:19 Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.

1 Cor. 10:13 (NIV) No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

Proverbs 4:14 (NIV) Do not set foot on the path of the wicked or walk in the way of evil men.

3. Seek the high ground

Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

1 Peter 3:9 (MsgB) That goes for all of you, no exceptions. No retaliation. No sharp-tongued sarcasm. Instead, bless—that's your job, to bless. You'll be a blessing and also get a blessing.

Luke 6:35-36 (MsgB) "I tell you, love your enemies. Help and give without expecting a return. You'll never—I promise—regret it. Live out this God-created identity the way our Father lives toward us, generously and graciously, even when we're at our worst. [36] Our Father is kind; you be kind.
